In response to your correspondence of August 20 and Mr. Heller's correspondence of September 11, I reiterate Mr. Heller's advisory that you are prohibited from contacting any of the defendants directly about this legal matter. Once a lawsuit has been filed, all communications with parties should be through their representatives, *i.e.*, Mr. Heller for PACT and its employees and board members and the undersigned for the City and Ms. Hawkins. Because you represent yourself, Mr. Heller and I will be communicating directly with you.

I would be happy to arrange a City facility at which we could meet to discuss the lawsuit. My suggestion is that we agree on a date the three of us could meet and schedule a hearing on defendants' dispositive motions the same day. In order for me to arrange a location and schedule the hearing, I will need at least thirty (30) days notice; with the exception of Friday, October 30, I am available the last week of October. Because I believe that depositions are premature (and a waste of the parties' resources) until the

cause(s) of action are more clearly defined, I am unable to agree to deposition dates at this time.
